TRIUNE GOD

1. Deuteronomy 6:4 - Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one.
2. Psalm 14:1 - The fool says in his heart, "There is no God."
3. Isaiah 42:8 - I am the Lord, that is My Name; I will not give my glory to another or my praise to idols.
4. Matthew 4:10 - Worship the Lord, your God and serve Him only.
5. Matthew 28:19 - Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
6. 2 Corinthians 13:14 - May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God the Father, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

CREATION

7. Genesis 1:1 - In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.
8. Psalm 124:8 - Our help is in the name of the Lord, Maker of heaven and earth.
9. Psalm 139: 14 - I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Your works are wonderful, I know that full well.
10. John 1:1-3 - In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.
11. Hebrews 11:3 - By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.
12. James 1:17 - Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights.

JESUS IS GOD

13. Isaiah 7:14 - Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and you shall call His Name Immanuel, which means "God with us".
14. Isaiah 9:6 - For unto us a Child is born; unto us a Son is given, and the government will be upon His shoulders. And His Name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
15. Matthew 10:32-33 - Whoever confesses Me before men, him will I confess before My Father in heaven. Whoever denies Me before men I will deny him before My Father in heaven.
16. Matthew 16:16 - Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."
17. Matthew 17:5 - "This is my Son, whom I love; with Him I am well pleased. Listen to Him!"
18. Matthew 28:18 - Then Jesus came to them and said: "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me."
19. John 1:14 - The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. And we have seen His glory, the glory of the only-begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.
20. John 5:23 - All may honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him.
21. Colossians 2:9 - For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form.
22. Hebrews 13:8 - Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

23. Leviticus 19:2 - Be holy because I, the Lord your God, am holy.
24. Matthew 5:48 - Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect.
25. Mark 12:30 - Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.

26. Galatians 3:10 - Cursed is everyone who does not continue to do everything written in the Book of the Law.
27. James 2:10 - For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles at just one point is guilty of breaking all of it.

SIN & CONFESSION

28. Genesis 8:21- The imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth.
29. Psalm 32:5 - I said, "I will confess my transgressions unto the Lord, and You forgave the guilt of my sin."
30. Psalm 51:5 - Surely I have been a sinner from birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me.
31. Psalm 51:17 - The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God - You will not despise.
32. Matthew 15:19 - For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false testimony, slander.
33. Luke 18:13 - God, have mercy on me, a sinner.
34. Romans 3:23 - For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.
35. Romans 7:18 - I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature.
36. Ephesians 2:1- You were dead in your transgressions and sins.
37. 1 John 1:8-9 - If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

GOSPEL INVITATION

38. Luke 2:10-11- Fear not: for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior which is Christ the Lord.
39. 1 Timothy 2:4 - God our Savior wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.
40. 2 Peter 3:9b - The Lord is not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

REDEMPTION & JUSTIFICATION

41. Genesis 3:15 - And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; He will crush your head and you will strike His heel.
42. Isaiah 43:1b - Fear not; I have redeemed you, I have called you by name; You are mine.
43. Romans 1:16 - I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes.
44. Romans 3:28 - A man is justified by faith, apart from observing the law.
45. Romans 5:1 - Since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.
46. Romans 6:23 - For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
47. Romans 8:1 - There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.
48. 2 Corinthians 5:19 - God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them.
49. 2 Corinthians 8:9 - For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, so that you through His poverty might become rich.
50. Ephesians 2:8-9 - For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God - not by works, so that no one can boast.
51. Titus 3:5-7 - He saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, Whom He poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that, having been justified by His grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.
52. 1 Peter 1:18-19 - You know that it was not with perishable things such as silver and gold that you were redeemed, but with the holy, precious blood of Christ, a Lamb without blemish or defect.
53. 1 John 2:1 - If anybody does sin, we have One who speaks to the Father in our defense - Jesus Christ, the Righteous One.

54. 1 John 3:1 - How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God!

SAVING WORK OF CHRIST

55. Isaiah 53:5-6 - But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon Him, and by His wounds we are healed. We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.
56. Matthew 20:28 - The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve and to give His life as a ransom for many.
57. Luke 19:10 - For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost.
58. John 1:29 - Behold, the Lamb of God, Who takes away the sin of the world.
59. Romans 4:25 - He was delivered for our offenses and was raised again for our justification.
60. 2 Corinthians 5:21 - God made Him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.
61. Galatians 3:13 - Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."
62. Galatians 4:4-5 - When the time had fully come, God sent His Son, born of a woman, born under law, to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons.
63. 1 Timothy 2:5 - For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men - the Man Christ Jesus.
64. Hebrews 4:15 - We have One who has been tempted in every way, just as we are, yet was without sin.
65. 1 John 2:2 - He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours, but also for the sins of the whole world.

SALVATION ONLY IN CHRIST

66. Isaiah 43:11 - I, even I, am the Lord; and apart from Me there is no Savior.
67. John 14:6 - I am the Way and the Truth and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.
68. Acts 4:12 - Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.

FORGIVENESS OF SINS

69. Psalm 103:11-12 - For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His love for those who fear Him; As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us.
70. Matthew 9:2 - Take heart, son; your sins are forgiven.
71. Luke 23:34 – Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.
72. Ephesians 4:32 - Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
73. 1 John 1:7 - The blood of Jesus Christ, His Son, cleanses us from all sin.
74. 1 John 1:8-10 - If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

FAITH

75. John 3:16 - For God so loved the world that He gave His only-begotten Son that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.
76. John 17:3 - Now this is eternal life: that they may know you, the only True God, and Jesus Christ, Whom You have sent.
77. John 20:29 - Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.

78. Acts 16:30-31 - "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved."
79. Romans 8:38-39 - For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
80. 1 Corinthians 12:3 - No one can say, "Jesus is Lord", except by the Holy Spirit.
81. Galatians 3:26 - You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.
82. 1 Timothy 6:12 - Fight the good fight of faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called.
83. Hebrews 11:1 - Faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.
84. Revelation 2:10 - Be faithful unto death, and I will give you the crown of life.

WORD OF GOD

85. Isaiah 55:11 - So is My Word that goes out from my mouth: it will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.
86. Psalm 119:105 - Your Word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path.
87. John 17:17 - Sanctify them through your truth, Your Word is truth.
88. John 10:35 - The Scripture cannot be broken.
89. John 20:31 - These are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name.
90. Romans 10:17 - Faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the Word of Christ.
91. 2 Timothy 3:15-17 - From infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness.

92. Hebrews 4:12 - For the Word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.
93. 2 Peter 1:21 - Prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

GUARD GOD'S WORD

94. Matthew 7:15 - Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly they are ferocious wolves.
95. John 8:31-32 - If you hold to My Word, you are truly my disciples. And you will know the truth and the truth will set you free.
96. Romans 16:17 - Watch out for those who cause divisions and offenses that are contrary to the teaching you have learned. Keep away from them.
97. 1 Corinthians 1:10 - Now I urge you brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.
98. 1 John 4:1 - Dear friends, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

BAPTISM

99. Matthew 28:19 - Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
100. Mark 16:16 - Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved; whoever does not believe will be condemned.
101. John 3:5-6 - No one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit.
102. Acts 2:38 - Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins.

103. Romans 6:4 - We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.
104. Galatians 3:26-27 - You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have been clothed with Christ.

THE LORD'S SUPPER

105. 1 Corinthians 10:16-17 - The cup which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ? For we, being many, are one bread and one body.
106. 1 Corinthians 11:23-25 - Our Lord Jesus Christ, the same night He was betrayed, took bread, and when He had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is given for you; do this in remembrance of me." In the same way, after supper He took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me."

THE CHURCH & WORSHIP

107. 1 Samuel 16:7 - Man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart.
108. Psalm 19:14 - May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, O Lord, my Strength and my Redeemer.
109. Psalm 51:10-12 - Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not from Your presence and take not Your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with Your free spirit.
110. Psalm 122:1 - I was glad when they said to me, "Let us go to the house of the Lord."
111. Matthew 18:20 - Where two or three are gathered together in My Name, there I am in the midst of them.

112. Luke 11:28 - Blessed are those who hear the Word of God and keep it.
113. John 4:24 - God is spirit, and His worshipers must worship in spirit and truth.
114. 1 Corinthians 3:11 - For no one can lay any other foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ.
115. Acts 2:42 - They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.
116. Ephesians 2:19-20 - Consequently, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus Himself as the chief cornerstone.
117. Ephesians 5:25-27 - Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the Word, and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless.
118. Colossians 3:16 - Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.
119. 2 Timothy 2:19 - The Lord knows those who are His.
120. Hebrews 10:25 - Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another - and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

MINISTRY

121. Luke 10:16 - He who listens to you listens to Me; he who rejects you rejects Me.
122. Acts 20:28 - Take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit had made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with his own blood.

123. Ephesians 4:11 - And Christ himself gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers.

MISSION WORK

124. Matthew 9:37-38 - The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.
125. Mark 16:15 - Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature.
126. 1 Corinthians 2:2 - For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified.
127. 1 Peter 3:15 - Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you the reason for the hope that is in you.

PRAYER

128. Matthew 7:7 - Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.
129. John 16:23 - I tell you the truth, my Father will give you whatever you ask in My Name.
130. James 5:16 - The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.

COMMITMENT

131. Deuteronomy 6:13 - Worship the Lord your God, and serve Him only.
132. Matthew 6:33 - Seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be given you as well.
133. Matthew 7:21 - Not everyone who says to Me, "Lord, Lord," will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven.
134. Matthew 10:37 - Anyone who loves his father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me; anyone who loves his son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
135. Matthew 16:24 - If anyone would come after Me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow Me.

136. Mark 8:36-37 - What good is it for a man to gain the whole world, yet forfeit his soul? Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul?

FIGHTING EVIL & TEMPTATION

137. Proverbs 1:10 - My son, if sinners entice you, do not give in to them.
138. Matthew 26:41 - Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing but the flesh is weak.
139. Romans 8:31,35 -If God be for us, who can be against us? ... We are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.
140. 1 Corinthians 10:13 - God is faithful, who will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear, but with the temptation will also make a way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.
141. Ephesians 6: 10-11 - Be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power. Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.
142. 2 Timothy 4:18 - The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to His heavenly kingdom.
143. 1 Peter 5:8-9 - Your enemy, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith.
144. 1 John 2: 15 - Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

CHRISTIAN LIVING

145. Matthew 5:16 - Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven.
146. John 15:5 - I am the Vine, you are the branches. If a man remains in Me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from Me you can do nothing.
147. 1 Corinthians 6: 19-20 - Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, Who is in you, Whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body.

148. 1 Corinthians 10:31 - So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.
149. 2 Corinthians 5:15 - Christ died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died for them and was raised again.
150. 2 Corinthians 5:17 - If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!
151. Galatians 5:22 - The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.
152. Galatians 6:10 - Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.
153. Ephesians 2:10 - We are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
154. Ephesians 4:24 - Put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.
155. Hebrews 11:6 - Without faith it is impossible to please God.
156. 1 Peter 2:9 - You are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His wonderful light.
157. 1 John 4:19 - We love Him because He first loved us.

CHRISTIAN GIVING

158. 2 Corinthians 9:7 - Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.
159. James 1:17 - Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights.

THANKSGIVING I CONTENTMENT

- 160. Genesis 32:10 - I am unworthy of all the kindness and faithfulness you have shown your servant.
- 161. Psalm 103:1 - Praise the Lord, O my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name.
- 162. Psalm 118:1 - O give thanks unto the Lord, for He is good; for His mercy endures forever.
- 163. Psalm 145:15-16 - The eyes of all look to You, and You give them their food at the proper time. You open your hand and satisfy the desires of every living thing.
- 164. Luke 12:15 - Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions.
- 165. 1 Timothy 6:6-8 - But godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it. But having food and clothing, we will be content.

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

- 166. Deuteronomy 6:6-7 - And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart; and you shall teach them diligently to your children.
- 167. Proverbs 22:6 - Train a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not turn from it.

MARRIAGE AND FAMILY

- 168. Matthew 19:6 - A man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife and the two will become one flesh. So they are no longer two, but one. Therefore what God has joined together, let not man separate.
- 169. Ephesians 5:32-33 - Husbands, love your wives as Christ loved the Church and gave Himself for her.
- 170. Ephesians 6:1 - Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.

171. Ephesians 6:4 - Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.

GOD'S REPRESENTATIVES

172. Acts 5:29 - We must obey God rather than men!
173. Romans 13:1 - Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The authorities that exist have been established by God.

COMFORT AND TRUST

174. Psalm 23 - The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures, He leadeth me beside the still waters, He restoreth my soul. He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for Thou art with me; Thy rod and Thy staff, they comfort me. Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies. Thou anointest my head with oil, my cup overflows. Surely goodness and mercy will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.
175. Psalm 37:5 - Commit your way to the Lord; trust also in Him and He will bring it to pass.
176. Psalm 37:25 - I was young and now I am old, yet I have never seen the righteous forsaken or their children begging bread.
177. Psalm 46:1 - God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.
178. Psalm 50:15 - Call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you and you will honor Me.
179. Psalm 73:25-26 - Whom have I in heaven but You? And earth has nothing I desire besides You. My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.
180. Proverbs 3:5 - Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding.

181. Isaiah 41:10 - Fear not, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with My righteous hand.
182. Isaiah 55:8-9 - "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways," declares the Lord. "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts."
183. Matthew 11:28 - Come to Me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.
184. Matthew 28:20 - Surely I am with you always, even to the very end of the world.
185. Acts 14:22 - We must through many hardships enter the kingdom of heaven.
186. Romans 8:28 - And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him.
187. Romans 8:38-39 - For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
188. 2 Corinthians 12:9 - My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.
189. Galatians 6:2 - Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.
190. 1 Peter 5:7 - Cast all your care on Him because He cares for you.

LAST THINGS

191. Matthew 24:36 - No one knows about that day or hour, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.
192. 2 Peter 3:10 - But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night. The heavens will pass away with a great roar; the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything in it will be burned up.
193. 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 - For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, and with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever.

CHRISTIAN DEATH & RESURRECTION
