## Field Trip to Carpenter Nature Center

We are excited to announce our first field trip in over 18 months! Grades 1-8 will be going to Carpenter Nature Center (located along the St. Croix River bluffs east of Hastings, MN) on Tuesday, October 19. We will be leaving school around 11:45. Our class starts at 12:30 and should last about an hour and a half. The topic is "Changing Seasons". For a portion of the class, the students will be divided into two groups—1-3 and 4-8. Most of the class will be outside, so students will need to dress for the weather. The nature center requires masks be worn for the indoor portion of the class (about 1/2 hour). We will bring along paper masks from school, but you may send masks along with your child that day. We will be returning to school by 2:45 pm.

Parents who would like to attend this field trip are asked to notify Mr. Thurow. We have one free adult admission per 5 student admissions, but we will pay for the extra adult admissions. 
## CLC Teachers' Conference
