
Field Trip to Carpenter Nature Center

Next Tuesday, October 19, Grades 1-8 will be going to Carpenter Nature Center (located along the St. Croix River bluffs east of Hastings, MN) We will be leaving school around 11:45. Our class starts at 12:30 and should last about an hour and a half. The topic is "Changing Seasons". For a portion of the class, the students will be divided into two groups—1-3 and 4-8. Most of the class will be outside, so students will need to dress for the weather. The nature center requires masks be worn for the indoor portion of the class (about 1/2 hour). We will bring along paper masks from school, but you may send masks along with your child that day. We will be returning to school by 2:45 pm.

Parents who would like to attend this field trip should notify Mr. Thurow as soon as possible. We have one free adult admission per 5 student admissions, but we will pay for the extra adult admissions. Please also let Mr. Thurow know if you are comfortable taking students other than your own children in your car or if you would prefer just transporting your own children.

CLC Teachers' Conference

After not meeting in 2020 due to the COVID pandemic, the 2021 CLC Teachers' Conference will be held in Hales Corners, Wisconsin, at Messiah Lutheran Church and School from Wednesday, Oct. 20 – Friday, Oct 22. The theme for the conference is "Building Blocks of Christian Education" based on I Timothy 1:13-14 ""Hold fast the pattern of sound words which you have heard from me, in faith and love which are in Christ Jesus. That good thing, which was committed to you, keep by the Holy Spirit who dwells in us." Topics include: Parents Role in Christian Education, Mobile Devices and Math, Student Led Activities, Impact of Nutrition on Learning, Instructional Activities That Work, BJU Press Curriculum Review (Berea faculty will be doing this presentation), The Congregation's Role in Christian Education, The Teacher's Role in Christian Education, The Divine Call, Breaking the Mental Block: Dyscalcula. All four teachers will be attending. School will be dismissed from Wednesday, Oct. 20-Friday, Oct. 22. School will resume Monday, Oct. 24th.
