Field Day

Field Day will be held next Friday, May 6th at Rich Valley Park. Field Day is normally an annual event, hosted by Berea, for 5th – 8th grade students from area CLC schools in which they compete in various track and field (and other sporting) events. We are excited to be able to hold this fun after 2 years off, providing our students with friendly competition and fellowship with area CLC

schools! All Berea 5th—8th graders will be participating. Students may participate in as many of the events as they wish. They do not have to participate in all of the events, but are encouraged to try as many as they would like. The event schedule and how the day will work will be explained to the students prior to Field Day. Events begin at 10:30 a.m. that day, and will conclude by 2:00 p.m., with a picnic lunch (provided by Berea) following. Berea upper grade students will be leaving for the park at around 10:00 that morning, and will be returning by 2:45 or so. **Parents of Grades 5-8: You may pick your child(ren) up at the park afterwards. Please let Mr. Thurow know as soon as possible if you plan on picking your child up at the park that day, or if you will pick them up at school at normal dismissal.** Since lunch will be later, and students will be fairly active prior to that, students are encouraged to bring a larger than normal “snack” to be eaten prior to leaving for the park that morning.

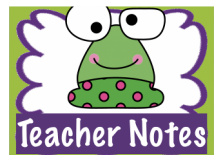
