Grades 5-8 Skiing Field Trip

The 5th—8th graders will be going on a skiing field trip on Friday, February 9th, at Hyland Hills Ski Area in Bloomington. We will be at the hill from 9 am until 2:30 pm and will return to school by 3 pm for normal dismissal. Ski and helmet rental, as well as a lift ticket is included with the field trip. Students will receive a comprehensive lesson, so all students will learn to ski, even if they have never skied before. Once they have completed the lesson, they will be skiing for the rest of the day. There will be adult skiing chaperones from Berea coming along. Lunch can be purchased on-site at the Hyland Grill, a cafeteria style food court, so students should bring money along if they wish to purchase lunch. Ten dollars is usually enough. Lunches may also be brought from home, but they should be brought in a cooler.

In general, students should dress in layers, with a waterproof shell and snowpants. Helmets will be worn by all skiers, so a hat is not necessary. Scarves should **not** be worn.


