Preschool Open House | Kindergarten Roundup

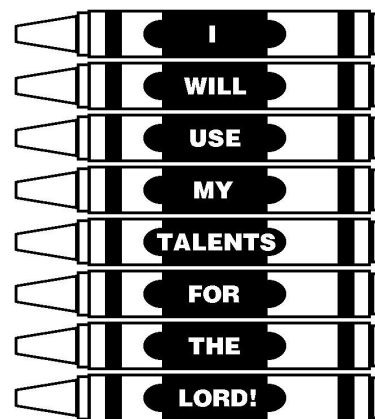
