## Calendar Changes

- Grandparents Day will be canceled for this year. We will look forward to having Grandparents Day during the 2021-2022 school year.
- The Band "Informance" will be held on Friday, April 9<sup>th</sup> as scheduled., but during the school day. (see note below)
- The Social Studies Fair will be moved to **Sunday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> at 2pm**. We will be having the fair outside, weather permitting. We are also reserving **May 16<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm** as our backup reschedule date for the Fair if the weather prevents us from holding it on May 2<sup>nd</sup>. Please take note of these dates. More details on the exact location, logistics, etc. for the fair will be upcoming. Also, look for information from your child's teacher regarding project guidelines and due dates coming in the next couple of weeks.

Another change is regarding Field Day, scheduled on our calendar for Friday, May 7<sup>th</sup>. Normally, Field Day is an event hosted by Berea where area CLC grade schools' 5<sup>th</sup>—8<sup>th</sup> graders participate in a fun day of events at Rich Valley Park. Due to the uncertainty of the availability of the park for an event such as this, as well as the situation regarding COVID, the Board of Education made the decision that Berea would not host this event this year. However, we are still planning on having some sort of Berea-only Field Day on that same day, Friday, May 7<sup>th</sup>, which will involve all Berea students and will take place here on our property.
