## Social Studies Fair

Some time near the end will be given for students to view each other's projects. Students should take home their projects after the fair that day, (once everyone has had a chance to view them). Families should check with their child's teacher before leaving the fair. Families are asked to park in the upper lot behind the Activity Center, and walk down to the front lot. Social distancing should be maintained as much as possible. Masks are not required, but may be worn if desired. Extended family and friends are invited to attend!

If weather causes a postponement, the alternate date for the fair will be Sunday, May 16, at 2 pm. A decision will be made by 8 am on Sunday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>.
