Grades 5-8 Skiing Field Trip

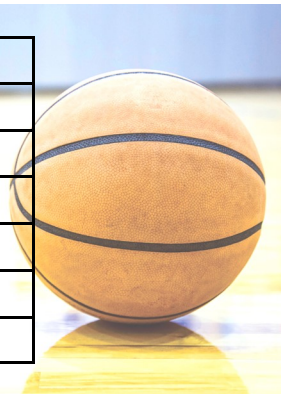
